Interpretation:

Molecular genetic analysis was performed for a specific mutation of the *P2RY12* gene reported to be associated with P2RY12 receptor platelet disorder in dogs. We identified two normal copies of the DNA sequences in the gene tested.

Recommendations:

No mutations were identified. Thus, this dog is not at an increased risk for the disease caused by or associated with the mutation tested. Normal results do not exclude inherited mutations not tested in this gene or other genes that may cause medical problems or may be passed on to offspring.
